Classifying your car: To classify your car in the CC classes, you start with the base points for your model of car and then add to them your tire size points and any performance equipment points

Base Points See zone8.pca.org or the 2019 rules booklet.

Tire Points Front tread width plus rear tread width (in mm) minus 410 = Points (Positive results only)

Performance Equipment Points - More Information (this is not a comprehensive list; please see the Zone 8 Rules Book for a complete listing): B. Soft compound high-performance tires DOT tread wear rating 140 – 200.

Add 80-pts DOT tread wear rating 1 - 49. Add 120-pts DOT tread wear rating 0 or Unrated. C. Race tires or slicks (Non-DOT) Add 140-pts

Induction system modification: Replacing older, stock electronic fuel injection or CIS with carburetors, mechanical fuel injection, or aftermarket EFI with Individual throttle bodies (or later-model Varioram system); replacement of stock carburetors with MFI or EFI systems; and/or modification of stock carburetor venturi and jetting configuration, upgraded CIS or Motronic fuel distributors, manifolds, throttle bodies or controllers (including ECU

In cases where the weight of the car is decreased by more than 1.5 percent of that listed in the Base Points chart the Base Points formula shall be recalculated using the new weight figure.
